## What Benefits does the ITZone Offer?

Meriden's ITZone offers two types of tax incentives: real property and personal property tax incentives. Real property tax incentives accrue to **property owners** who construct or newly improve their buildings to house IT businesses. The incentive, based on the cost of improvements, will be in the form of a tax break on the increased assessment resulting from the same improvements. The minimum new investment required is \$25,000. The tax break will be from 50% to 100% on the tax increase for terms of two to six years.

**IT business tenants** may also receive tax abatements for 3 years on IT personal property new to Meriden's tax rolls. This abatement will be 100% for the first two years and 50% in the third year.
